



Apple will start making its own screens instead of buying from Samsung and LG. The first Apple-made screen will be on the Apple watch. In the future, they might also make screens for iPhones. Apple intends to switch entirely to Apple-created screens by 2024. This is a step for Apple to become less reliant on other companies and mainly produce all their supplies. For example, they stopped using Intel's CPUs and now make their own. Instead of an OLED display, they plan to use a micro LED. Wei Chen, part of Johny Johny Srouji's Hardware Technologies division at Apple, engineered this type of LED. In the future, Apple will mostly make everything needed for technology.





Author: Raina Telgemeier



A: My current favorite thing to do is pottery.


Q: What is your favorite book/series/author?




